However, the examination of the elective courses for **Advanced Course on Copyright Law & Liberty, Equality and Justice** will be held in the **Evening between 04.00 p.m. and 05.30 p.m.**
2. All the Mid-Semester Examinations for **First Year and Third Year B.A. LL.B. (Hons) and B.Com. LL.B. (Hons)** Degree programme will be held in the **afternoon between 02.00 p.m. and 03.30 p.m.** at the UG Block as per the above mentioned schedule. However, the courses of **POLITICAL SCIENCE –III and HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT** for **Third Year B.A. LL.B. (Hons) and B.Com. LL.B. (Hons)** Degree programme will be held in the **forenoon between 10.00 a.m. and 11.30 a.m.**
3. Students should produce the Identity Card on demand by the Invigilator / Authorities of the TNNLU during the Examinations.
4. No student shall be allowed to leave the Examination Hall before the expiry of 45 Minutes from the time of commencement of the examination. Students will be permitted to leave the examination hall only on submission of answer book to Invigilator and they will not be permitted to re-enter.
5. Students should write their Register Number, Course of the Examination and Date of the Examination at the appropriate space provided in the main answer book only.
6. Any student who writes his/her Register Number on any part of the answer book/sheets other than in the space provided or makes any special mark or marking which may disclose in any way the identity of the student, will be liable for disciplinary action.
7. Students are strictly instructed to keep all the belonging including books and materials only inside the Examination Hall.
8. Mobile phones and Electronic Gadgets (including Smart Watches) are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall.
