Amba Kak is currently a Mozilla Tech Policy Fellow, former Google Policy Fellow, and a Rhodes Scholar. She has previously worked as legal consultant at the National Institute of Public Finance & Policy, an

autonomous research institute under the Ministry of Finance, Government of India. She attended the University of Oxford with the support of the Rhodes scholarship, and has degrees in law (BCL at the Law faculty) and internet studies (MSc at the Oxford Internet Institute).

Mr. Suhrith Parthasarathy is an independent practitioner of law, living and writing in Chennai. He graduated in law from the National University of Juridical Sciences, and in journalism from Columbia University. He currently practices as an advocate at the Madras High Court.



Mr. Pranesh Prakash was part of the founding team at CIS and is currently Policy Director at the organization. He works on policy research and advocacy around intersections of technology and law focusing on access to knowledge (primarily copyright reforms), promoting 'openness' (including open government data, open standards, open access, and free/libre/open source software), and freedom of expression, privacy, and internet governance.
